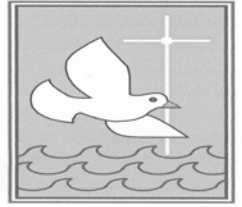

## FORMATION for INFANT BAPTISM



The Diocese of Pueblo and Saint Mary Parish require that parents and godparents seeking to baptize an infant or young child participate in a minimum of six hours of sacrament formation classes. **Baptism Formation classes in English** are offered three times each year on four consecutive Tuesday evenings in the Winter, Spring, and Fall. Participants are required to attend all four classes.

There will be a fee of \$25.00 payable at the first session for books and resources. Contact Yvonne at the Parish Center for additional information.

PARENTS and GODPARENTS are reminded that they must contact Yvonne or Silvia to schedule baptisms and that baptisms will be celebrated only on certain Sundays each month. It's a good idea to schedule the baptism with the Church before you reserve a party site or make airline reservations for out-of-town guests.
