A POSSIBLE ADJUSTMENT TO OUR SERVER PROGRAM

We are so fortunate to have young people serving in the Sacred Liturgy. The primary reason for serving is to foster vocational discernment, especially to the priesthood and consecrated life.

For that reason, we are considering splitting boys and girls into two new programs: Altar Boys and the Daughters of St. Therese. Each of these groups would serve the Lord in the Sacred Liturgy in a particular way.

The Altar Boys would serve primarily the action of the Sacred Liturgy, focused on the altar and assisting the priest directly.

The Daughters of St. Therese (girls), named for St. Therese of Lisieux, Carmelite nun and Doctor of the Church, would primarily serve in the preparations of the Sacred Liturgy as sacristans.

We would start the new programs in late Summer/Fall 2025. Until that time, your child may continue to serve the altar as he/she has been doing.

UN POSIBLE AJUSTE A NUESTRO PROGRAMA DE SERVIDORES

Somos muy afortunados de tener jóvenes sirviendo en la Sagrada Liturgia. La razón principal de servir es fomentar el discernimiento vocacional, especialmente al sacerdocio y la vida consagrada.

Por esa razón, estamos considerando dividir a niños y niñas en dos nuevos programas: Monaguillos y las Hijas de Santa Teresa. Cada uno de estos grupos serviría al Señor en la Sagrada Liturgia de una manera particular.

Los monaguillos servirían principalmente a la acción de la Sagrada Liturgia, centrándose en el altar y asistiendo directamente al sacerdote.

Las Hijas de Santa Teresa (niñas), llamadas así por Santa Teresa de Lisieux, monja carmelita y doctora de la Iglesia, servirían principalmente en los preparativos de la Sagrada Liturgia como sacristanas.

Comenzaríamos los nuevos programas a finales del verano/otoño de 2025. Hasta ese momento, su hijo puede continuar sirviendo en el altar como lo ha estado haciendo.
