Please be merciful to the priest and thoughtful towards others:

The priest needs time to spiritually prepare for the offering of Mass. If you need to talk with him, ask him a question, or have him bless something, please do not approach him before Mass begins, but only AFTER Mass, once everyone else has had the chance to greet him. Also, on Saturdays, if you notice that it is already 3:45 pm, nobody else should still be in line waiting for confession. Otherwise, you make the priest late for Mass, and everyone else has to wait. If you are not able to get to confession during the usual times, please make an appointment at extension 17.

Teach Your Children to Use GPS

After Mass today, have a conversation with your children, asking, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" After a few moments of discussion, ask, "Who do you think God wants you to be when you grow up?" Emphasize to your children that God has a specific plan in mind for them, and that following God's plan is the surest way to happiness. Every life decision—which college to attend, whom to date, which job to pursue, whether to enter seminary, whom to marry—should be undertaken only after praying for God's guidance. In other words, encourage kids to navigate life using GPS—God's Positioning System.
