From the Desk of the Music Director, Jacinta Scheetz,

As we mentioned last week, following Vatican II there was a hiccup when it came to preserving the traditional music of the Church. Besides allowing for the use of the vernacular as well as Latin in the Mass, Vatican II also changed the cycle of readings and propers from 1 year to 3 years to include more of Sacred Scripture. When Vatican II was promulgated musical settings for the new antiphons and psalms were not ready, and many musical settings for the propers of the Mass had not been adjusted for the translations into native tongues. Permission was given to use hymns in place of the traditional entrance, offertory, and communion antiphons, and there was a rush to create musical settings for the propers in vernacular languages, and in the chaos, the traditional music of the Church all but disappeared. It took nearly 60 years, but more and more musicians have answered the call to preserve the traditional music of the Church and have begun adapting traditional melodies to go with approved translations, and have begun writing new music that carefully adheres to the direction laid out in *Sacrosanctum Concilium* and *Musicam Sacram*. Missal companies such as Source and Summit are leading the charge in successfully integrating old and new while preserving the sacred character and atmosphere of the Divine Liturgy. We will begin using their missal/hymnal in the Fall, and if you wish to do a deeper dive into Sacred music, they have many excellent articles on their blog. <https://www.sourceandsummit.com/blog>

NEW Hymnals from Source and Summit coming soon!

This Advent we will be getting new hymnals from Source and Summit instead of using Breaking Bread and we are very excited about it!

Because of the switch, our copy right for Breaking Bread ends in mid-September and we were unable to extend it a few more months.

Our solution, since we have all the copy rights to Source and Summit online now, we will be using music that is in **BOTH** Source and Summit and Breaking Bread. However, the Mass parts are different, so we will be learning the **NEW** Mass parts from the **Mass of St. Philip Neri**, over the next few weeks.

Como mencionamos la semana pasada, después del Vaticano II hubo un problema a la hora de preservar la música tradicional de la Iglesia. Además de permitir el uso de la lengua vernácula y del latín en la Misa, el Vaticano II también cambió el ciclo de lecturas y propios de 1 año a 3 años para incluir más Sagrada Escritura. Cuando se promulgó el Vaticano II, los arreglos musicales para las nuevas antífonas y salmos no estaban listos, y muchos arreglos musicales para los propios de la Misa no habían sido ajustados para las traducciones a las lenguas nativas. Se dio permiso para usar himnos en lugar de las tradicionales antífonas de entrada, ofertorio y comunión, y hubo prisa por crear escenarios musicales para los propios en lenguas vernáculas, y en el caos, la música tradicional de la Iglesia prácticamente desapareció. Tomó casi 60 años, pero cada vez más músicos han respondido al llamado de preservar la música tradicional de la Iglesia y han comenzado a adaptar melodías tradicionales para que coincidan con las traducciones aprobadas, y han comenzado a escribir nueva música que se adhiere cuidadosamente a la dirección establecida en Sacrosanctum Concilium y Musicam Sacram. Compañías de misales como Source y Summit están liderando la tarea de integrar con éxito lo antiguo y lo nuevo, preservando al mismo tiempo el carácter sagrado y la atmósfera de la Divina Liturgia. Comenzaremos a usar su misal/himnario en el otoño y, si desea profundizar en la música sacra, tienen muchos artículos excelentes en su blog. <https://www.sourceandsummit.com/blog>

Financial Report for the Fiscal Year July 2023 – June 2024

Thanks be to God, we had another good year! Our offertory (collections) totaled \$725,700, and with extra donations it allowed us the flexibility to complete some needed projects to keep our operations healthy. The work included addressing the termite infestation, upgraded lighting in the main church, paying for our parish subscription to FORMED.org, the opportunity to help Sharing Ministries, new doors to help with the noise from receptions in the hall, a dump trailer to save on costs for mowing, and making it possible to host the Totus Tuus missionaries for the youth summer camp.

Together with our regular expenses for upkeep and paying all our bills, the total expenses for the year came to \$649,392. The small surplus allows us some security in case any unexpected needs arise. We're right where we need to be, thanks to all your generosity. Please keep it up, remembering that giving from what we have been blessed with, allows us to grow spiritually and be a blessing to others. May the Lord continue to guide our community in the ways of faith, hope, and love!

Informe financiero del ejercicio fiscal de julio 2023 – junio 2024

Gracias a Dios, tuvimos otro año bueno! Nuestra colecta totalizó \$725,700 y, con donaciones adicionales, nos dio la flexibilidad para completar algunos proyectos necesarios para mantener nuestras operaciones en buen estado. El trabajo incluyó terminar con la plaga de termitas, mejorar la iluminación en la iglesia principal, pagar la suscripción de nuestra parroquia a FORMED.org, la oportunidad de ayudar al Ministerio de compartir, nuevas puertas para ayudar con el ruido de las recepciones en el salón, un remolque de volteo para ahorrar costos de corte de césped y fue posible albergar a los misioneros Totus Tuus para el campamento de verano para jóvenes.

Junto con nuestros gastos regulares de mantenimiento y el pago de todas nuestras facturas, los gastos totales del año ascendieron a \$649,392. La pequeña cantidad restante nos permite cierta seguridad en caso de que surjan necesidades inesperadas. Estamos justo donde debemos estar, gracias a toda su generosidad. 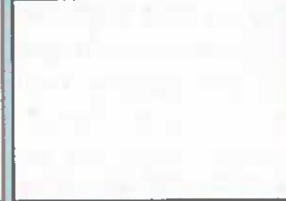


