Eucharistic Revival

Does the Church consider Saturday evening Mass same as Sunday Mass? Is my Sunday obligation fulfilled if I went for Saturday evening Mass? The Church permits going to Mass on Saturday evening instead of on Sunday, and it doesn't have to be an emergency. Sunday is the most important and holiest day of the week for us as Christians because it is the day of Christ's Resurrection. Our participation in the Eucharist on Sunday is our celebration of the new Passover—of Jesus' Passion, death, and Resurrection for our salvation. That is why we are required to go to Mass every Sunday. At the same time, there is also an ancient tradition (going back even to Judaism) of keeping the *vigil*. A vigil is an observance of a holy day on the evening before (sometimes into the night). Even the word "vigil" comes from Latin for "watchful" or "keeping awake."

The reason that a Mass on Saturday evening satisfies the Sunday obligation is because the Saturday evening Mass is a *vigil Mass* for Sunday—you're *anticipating* the celebration of Sunday on the evening before! So as long as the Mass being celebrated is a vigil Mass for Sunday, then it 100% satisfies your obligation. In the eyes of the Church, a Saturday vigil *is* a Sunday Mass. You can also check what the Church teaches on the Sunday obligation in the Catechism and in the Code of Canon Law. The Catechism speaks about the Sunday obligation in sections 2180-2183 and the Code in canons 1246-1248.

Canon 1248 – The precept of participating in the Mass is satisfied by assistance at a Mass which is celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the holy day or on the evening of the preceding day.

¿Considera la Iglesia que la misa del sábado por la noche es igual a la misa del domingo? ¿Se cumple mi obligación dominical si fui a la misa del sábado por la noche? La Iglesia permite ir a Misa el sábado por la noche en lugar del domingo, y no tiene por qué ser una emergencia. El domingo es el día más importante y sagrado de la semana para nosotros como cristianos porque es el día de la Resurrección de Cristo. Nuestra participación en la Eucaristía el domingo es nuestra celebración de la nueva Pascua, de la Pasión, muerte y Resurrección de Jesús por nuestra salvación. Por eso estamos obligados a ir a misa todos los domingos. Al mismo tiempo, también existe una antigua tradición (que se remonta incluso al judaísmo) de mantener la vigilia. Una vigilia es la observancia de un día santo en la noche anterior (a veces hasta la noche). Incluso la palabra "vigilia" proviene del latín para "vigilar" o "mantenerse despierto". La razón por la que una Misa el sábado por la noche satisface la obligación del domingo es porque la Misa del sábado por la noche es una Misa de vigilia para el domingo: ¡estás anticipando la celebración del domingo la noche anterior! Entonces, siempre que la Misa que se celebre sea una Misa de vigilia para el domingo, entonces cumple al 100% con su obligación. A los ojos de la Iglesia, una vigilia de sábado es una misa de domingo.

También puedes consultar lo que enseña la Iglesia sobre la obligación dominical en el Catecismo y en el Código de Derecho Canónico. El Catecismo habla de la obligatoriedad del domingo en los artículos 2180-2183 y el Código en los cánones 1246-1248.

Canon 1248 – El precepto de participar en la Misa se cumple con la asistencia a una Misa que se celebra en cualquier lugar de rito católico, ya sea el día de hoy o la tarde del día anterior.

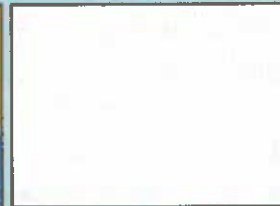
