We have watched a total of 1,413 videos, totaling 850 hours of viewing. The cost of this year's subscription is \$2,199. Fr. Matthew's Recommendations

#1 – Practice TALKING WITH GOD

- Choose how often and for how long (e.g. 15 minutes per day, or 3 times a week for 30 minutes each session).
- Tell God what's happening with you personally, ask Him a question(s), and pause regularly to learn how to just sit quietly and receive from Him what He wants to give.
- Finally, journal your experience of prayer (e.g. what you noticed about your thoughts, feelings, and desires – plus the effect it had on you), for helpful insights or questions.

#2 – Experiment With DIGITAL FASTING

- Be honest about trouble areas (e.g. times of day or specific kinds of social media).
- Set reasonable limits (e.g. notifications turned off or deleting certain apps).
- Schedule times when acceptable to use the internet, using a timer for accountability.

#3 – Learn Something About THE HOLY MASS

- Set up free account at FORMED.org/signup (enter 81401 for St. Mary's, Montrose; with your name and email).
- Type "Mass" in the search bar.
- Find a video that catches your attention and watch it.

Bonus = Meet with a small group (3 – 4 people) regularly, to practice WALKING WITH OTHERS, sharing how it's going with regards to any of the above recommendations, and helping each other avoid pitfalls or try different approaches for better results. For example, try completing one of the programs on FORMED.org such as *Elements of the Catholic Mass*, *A Scriptural Walk Through The Mass*, or *Real & True: Eucharistic Revival* (which is especially good for young people).

Recomendaciones del Padre Mateo

#1 – Practica **HABLANDO CON DIOS**

- Elija con qué frecuencia, como 15 minutos cotidianamente o 30 minutos 3 veces por semana.
- Cuéntale a Dios lo que te está pasando personalmente, hazle una(s) pregunta(s), y haz una pausa regularmente para aprender cómo recibir de Dios en el silencio.
- Escribe de tu experiencia, como anotar tus pensamientos, sentimientos y deseos, además del efecto que tuvo en ti, para obtener inspiraciones o preguntas útiles.

#2 – Experimenta con un **AYUNO DIGITAL**

- Se honesto acerca de las áreas problemáticas, como los tipos de redes sociales.
- Haga los sacrificios necesarios, como desactivar notificaciones o eliminar ciertas apps.
- Ponte límites de tiempo para usar la tecnología, y use un cronómetro para guardarlo.

#3 – Aprenda algo sobre **LA SANTA MISA**

- Configure una cuenta gratuita en FORMED.org/signup (ingrese 81401 para St. Mary's, Montrose; con su nombre y correo electrónico).
- En el sitio donde están los videos, se pone en la búsqueda "Misa".
- Encuentra un video que te llame la atención y míralo.

EXTRA = Reúnase como grupo pequeño (3 – 4 personas) unas veces para practicar **CAMINANDO CON OTROS**, compartiendo cómo les va con las recomendaciones, y ayudarse mutuamente a evitar obstáculos o probar diferentes enfoques para obtener mejores resultados. Por ejemplo, intente completar uno de los cursos de FORMED.org: *Jesús y la Eucaristía*, *Presencia: El Misterio de la Eucaristía*, o *La Misa Explicada*.

St. Blaise was probably born to a noble and wealthy family, who provided him with a Christian education. He went on to become a physician, but eventually was chosen and consecrated a Bishop. During one of the last persecutions of the Church by the Romans, St. Blaise went to live as a hermit in a cave outside of town, where he was known to heal the sick. Ultimately, he was discovered and he was taken to the governor of Cappadocia, and thrown into jail. St. Blaise was asked to renounce his faith and when he wouldn't, he was martyred. St. Blaise is invoked at the blessing of throats, because when he was in prison, he miraculously cured a young boy who was choking to death on a fishbone stuck in his throat.

Blessing of the Throats will be after all the Masses on February 3rd and 4th.

San Blas probablemente nació en una familia noble y rica, que le proporcionó una educación cristiana. Luego se convirtió en médico, pero finalmente fue elegido y consagrado obispo. Durante una de las últimas persecuciones de la Iglesia por parte de los romanos, San Blas se fue a vivir como ermitaño a una cueva en las afueras de la ciudad, donde era conocido por curar a los enfermos. Al final, fue descubierto, llevado ante el gobernador de Capadocia y encarcelado. A San Blas se le pidió que renunciara a su fe y cuando no lo hizo, fue martirizado. San Blas es invocado en la bendición de las gargantas, porque cuando estaba en prisión curó milagrosamente a un joven que moría asfixiado con una espina de pescado clavada en su garganta.

La Bendición de las Gargantas será después de todas las Misas del 3 y 4 de febrero.
